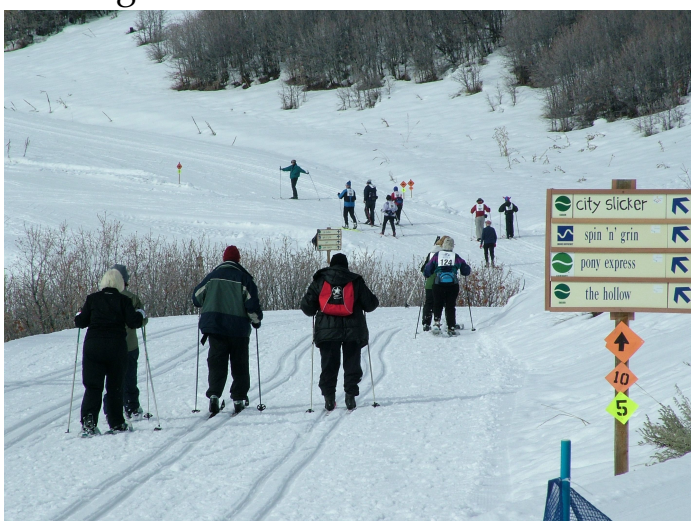


An Extraordinary Experience
