Each disabled participant is paired with an experienced cross-country skier for six days of instruction, practice and fun on the snow. Off the snow activities include a welcome reception, auction and talent night. SFL attracts more than 250 active adults from across the U.S. and around the world. This year's 34th annual Ski for Light International Week will take place in Utah, from Sunday, February 1 through Sunday, February 8, 2009. Participants will ski at Soldier Hollow Cross-Country Ski Resort, site of the 2002 Olympic cross-country skiing and biathlon events, and stay at the Marriott Hotel & Conference Center in Provo.
